


What did you do in between finishing your bachelor studies and starting the MMM?




MMM-Areas: Specialization and Satisfaction







General comments

Machine Learning Applications in Finance. Generally more courses with focus on things like Data Analytics, the website states this an separate area of specialization, but the few courses stated there are actually just a collection of MKT, OPM and some core courses.

Some Business Analytics courses were taken out of the course catalogue that would have been interesting for me and other students. E.g. concerning Big data science

A course similar to OPM 662 related to logistics topics

More Sales courses within the Marketing area and definitely an even stronger focus on digital!

Empirical methods with a professor willing to teach and offering appropriate teaching material

The module catalogue is lacking completely Controlling courses! The only course (managerial accounting) was cancelled....

I believe the Practical Computer Science elective could offer some more courses from the CS bachelor, since the IS courses in the MMM teach the necessary knowledge. E.g., CS405, CS414, CS408.

the controlling course which has been cancelled for over 2 years - some more practical Finance courses related to M&A, PE and VC instead of the high empirical and theoretical focus of the current catalogue

Comments: **Seminar Thesis**



"The ECTS points assigned is too low. Especially when compared to the bachelor thesis or the master thesis. At least 8 ECTS would be fair."

"Unfavorable ECTS to effort ratio"

"Had a very engaged supervisor, which was great. However, grades etc. were not rewarding, especially considering the workload." "(...)It would be helpful to have a central page where all deadlines and chairs that offer are seminar thesis are shown in an overview."

Management Area:

 - Standardization of application timeframe > "The finance chairs manage this very well; should also be doable for management"

"Very good approach at the **CSR chair** (...) empirical work and data analysis, but **group work** (4p) and very close guidance by supervisors which compensated for extra work, also introduction to data analysis (...) (however, was with spss, could maybe be with R or other since more people will use this in thesis), plus fair grading - all in all, **very happy!**"

Finance Area:

- the **variety** of topics was **poor**. "Why not introduce some diversity and by that meet the preferences of more students?"
- no possibility to make topic proposals
 - presentation makes up too high percentage ("40% or sometimes 50% means the paper itself weights very little which does not justify the workload")



If yes, which one? (n = 24)










Electives: Satisfaction








Comments: Open-Book Exams (I)



"The time pressure is really insane especially in subjects where we have case (...). I would much rather be observed via zoom or other platforms when writing the exam if the exams are more doable, than to have an open book exam, where I cannot even read the questions in time"

"Overall online exams are very nice but there are some minor negative aspects too - Too much time pressure; without upload and download extra time you cannot finish the exam (...) if someone has technical problems it should be handled with more considerateness"

"(...)The stress of being responsible for the technical equipment is an additional stress factor I would prefer not to have."

"Give us more time!"

Copy and Paste of slides in online exams does not make sense

"Klausuren bei denen man nicht zu vorigen Fragen zurück kann, sind meiner Meinung nach sehr unfair und sehe auch keinen Grund warum diese teilweise so durchgeführt wurden"

"Live online exams: The text box was way too small so that you had to scroll all the time. This was really time consuming and distracting - especially with regards to calculations. Thus, one should be allowed to write in word or scan the solutions.(...)"









Comments: Open-Book Exams (II)



Offline Exams are possible at many other German universities. I wonder why it is not even considered in Mannheim"

"Please don't do it after Covid-19 is over. It's nice to have the opportunity to look things up in the slides but it's just not a controlled environment." Fear that other people cheat, which makes it unfair for those who don't

"By their nature they suggest that people have access to previous exams so **don't reuse them** (...)"

"I much prefer the format to regular exams. I feel it is now much more about understanding the topics than it is about learning stuff by heart."

"the **practice-oriented implementation** of the exams (i.e. little business cases etc.) is a better reflection of a student's skills (...) than learning content by heart and writing down of definitions etc. as this does not reflect whether a student understood the course contents at all."

"Please **keep the format** of online open-book exams also after the Corona pandemic. **I learn way more** if I prepare for an open book exam than for a normal exam."

"(...) did make a difference in the way I studied for exams. I focused more on understanding instead of memorizing a definition word for word."














ACC 540 – Financial Statement Analysis & Equity Valuation

It was quite difficult to follow the exercise sessions since rarely any explanations were provided. Furthermore, there were mistakes in the solutions provided.

unfair exam, impossible to finish in time, lecture does not prepare sufficient for the exam. The case study was very insightful but also a lot of work. The course overall is interesting, but the exercise was done very poorly, and the exam was just unfair.

Way too much work for too few ECTS; Professor promised to improve exam and grading but did hardly anything; If he promises the same next semester, I wouldn't believe him anymore

Too much content; rather reduce content and go a little bit more into detail in some topics / aspects

TAX 630 – International Business Taxation

An awful lot of work and way too many slides. Not recommended.

ACC Seminar

Comments: IS Courses



IS 512 – IT Management in the Digital Age

Great professor, subject is a bit boring on its own but he showed great experience and engaged the students

Grading criteria not available at all. Very late exam review (still waiting for it). The professors was nice and seemed to be very interested in the learning success of the students. However, participation in case study declined bc professor talked so much

Exam questions and sample solutions seemed pretty random

Great case studies

Exam grading was a lot harsher than what he showcased previously

IS 541 – Thoeries and Methods in Information Systems

Well suites if you are somewhat interested in academic work and nice prep for seminar or master thesis

MAN 654 – Corporate Restructuring

Sound lecture, sound contents, well done.

Block courses are exhausting but having only 2 weeks to prepare a 60min presentation is though. Would be nice to have at least one more week especially since every course wants to have a presentation in the middle of the semester

poor communication that in-depth background knowledge in finance is required, i.e. should be stated that it is recommended to attend Corporate Finance I. Otherwise, students are not able to do the exercises/ presentations and fully grasp the lecture!

Grading was random and without proper arguments

MAN 633 – Entrepreneurial Spirit

Bad communication from the teaching staff.

MAN 655 Corporate Corporate Strategy: Managing Business Groups

Exam was too hard and the exercises (like calculations) came to a surprise since we did not do in class

Very poor exam! The exam did not at all cover the material considered as "key takeaways" in the lecture. Lecture material and recordings are not suitable for exam preparation

MAN 648 Incentives and Performance

Interesting start, rather boring SAP-lecture and very theoretical professor's lecture part.

Different speakers made the course more lifely but the first one was kind of hard to listen to due to a lack of very good English skills

Biemann makes it very interesting as usual

Comments: MKT Courses (I)



MKT 520 - Market Research

I took this course because it's important, but the course organization and the professor and the TA always ignore the students - any questions in the forum, any requests for materials... Of ~300 slides, the professor refused to share 100 slides with us.

parts of the exam content/topics have never been covered in the exercises/lectures

Too many overlaps with empirical methods. Exam did not match course content at all.

Professor and TA totally disconnected from the course - no response to online forums, emails... They upload recordings with a min. 5-day delay, prof. Kraus shared only two-thirds of the slides with us, the rest not. Test had questions that made no sense.

Tutor was yelling at the students

A math course without too much math and on a level that shouldn't be tought outside of a bachelor's level course

MKT 531 – Marketing Theory

just read from a book, Word by Word. He basically did nothing himself.

Much content for 4 ECTS bur interesting

MKT 545 – Customers, Markets and Firm Strategy

Very flexible course structure, highly engaged chair

too much math involved in this course

Pre-recorded lectures are awful

Interesting topics, fair exam.
