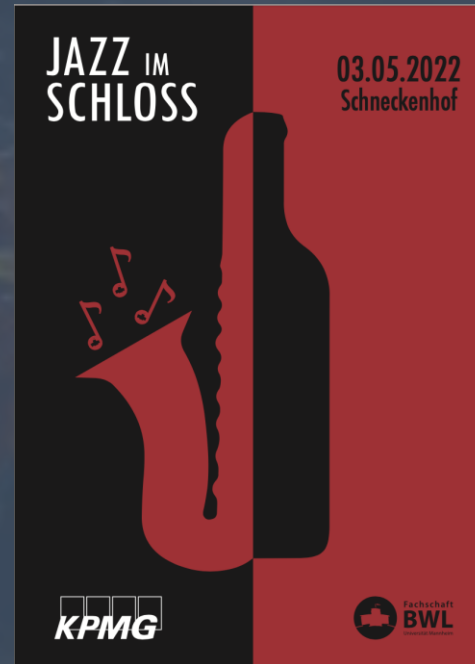

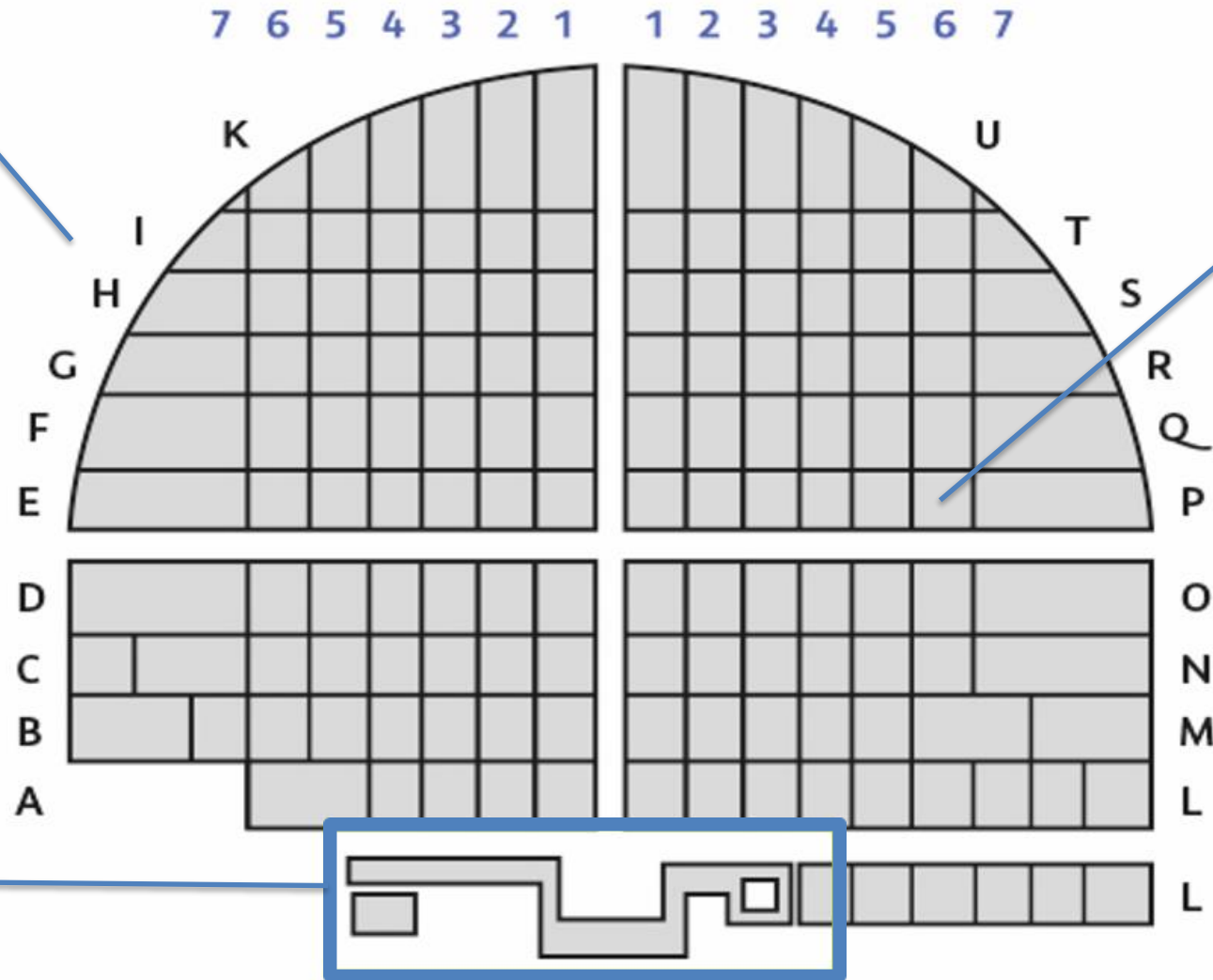

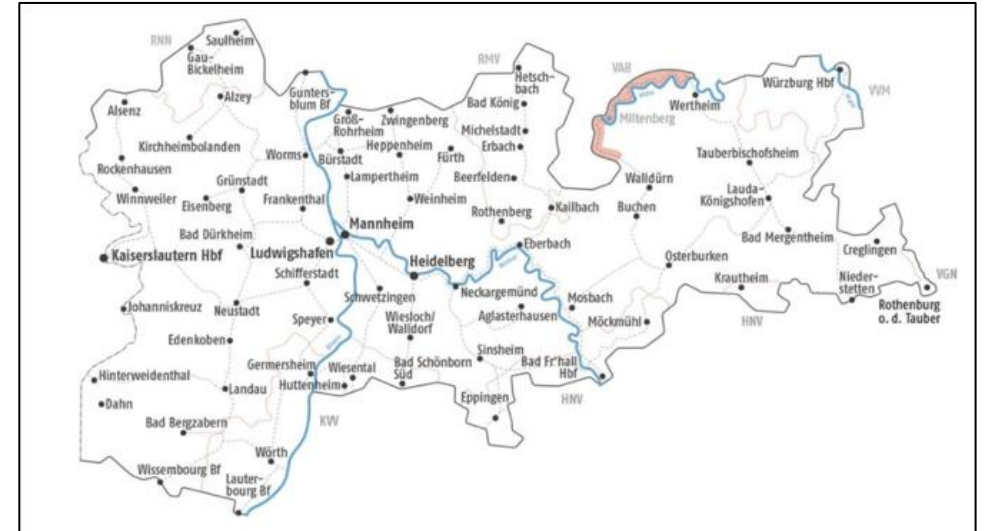

- Most things are within walking distance



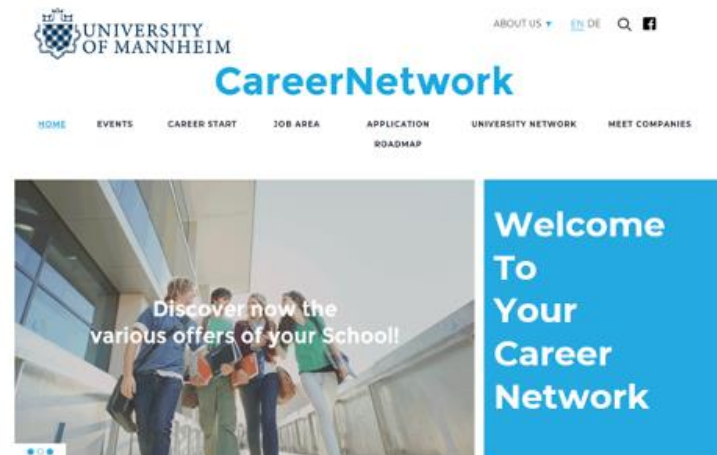

Restricted Courses



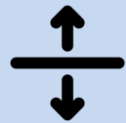
Deadline Registration for Restricted Courses: **01.09. | 11:59 pm (Thursday)**

- Status in the student portal (Portal 2) until then: "registered"



Announcement of which courses you got into: **02.09.** (Friday)

- Courses are assigned by lot – no first-come-first-serve
- Status in the student portal (Portal 2) will change to "admitted" / "rejected"



Withdrawal / Move-up phase: **02.09. - 11.09.**

- BE FAIR and de-register from course you don't want to take after all
- Check the student portal (Portal 2) to see whether you moved up into a course

Non-restricted Courses

All other non-restricted courses: take / drop them during the semester as you wish

Course registration ≠ Exam registration!

Deadlines

- Double Degree: **30. September**
- Semester Abroad: **31. October** (for both HWS 23 / FSS 24)

Proof of language proficiency

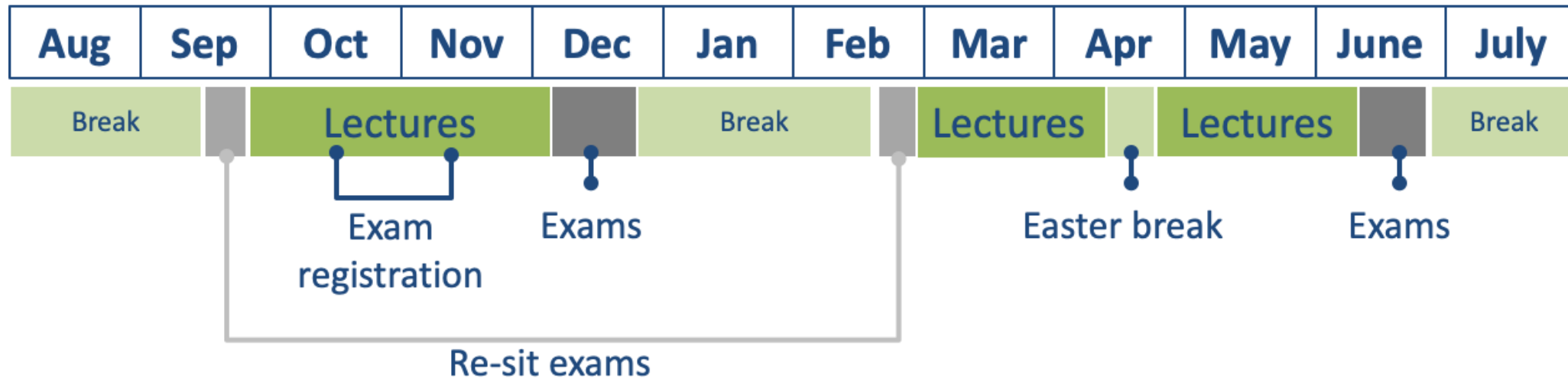
- Don't forget your proof of language proficiency!
 - By the application deadline: not older than TWO YEARS (exceptions possible – please check the partner university data base)
 - Find out which type of certificate is needed for the universities you're interested in (Toefl, Language Certificate of the University of Mannheim, ...)
 - Make an appointment for the test
