# Why did you choose the University of Mannheim for your master studies? (multiple answers possible)










#### Fall Term 2020: Sources of Information

### Comments: Application Process (I)



**ECTS requirements** were not clear until I send my list of subjects, firstly it looked like that I cannot apply for MMM

Keep it online! Also **immatriculation certificates should be available online**, no one needs them in paper anymore.

The online application tool is a little unhandy. Especially, when there was one document to hand in later, you had to delete the whole application and do another one.

The period between the admission and the enrollment was very short, so it was very difficult to get all necessary documents in such short time especially under corona circumstances

Applicants should be sent confirmations when their documents arrived at the Studienbüro.



How would you rate the effort-credits ratio of this course?





Great online teaching, quality was way beyond any business courses

Even though the professor put a lot of effort into the course, I cannot see which learnings I should take away from it.

In my opinion, it was not fair to provide multiple exams varying in difficulty for the online exam.

Due to many different versions of the final exam with completely different

difficulty level, the performance is **not** comparable among students and students cannot be graded using the same criteria!

Great Prof. The course was well **structured**. It offered a lot of possibilities to learn the content.

> It was failed to provide students with a mock exam that resembles the actual structure of the exam (which was different as it was the first one to be conducted online and open book)





Have you started/completed a seminar thesis this semester?






## Seminar Thesis: Choice of Timing and Chair


#### ...the opportunity to influence your topic?




#### ...the formal support by the chair?



If yes, which one?










## **Electives: Satisfaction and Comments**








### **ACC 520 IFRS Reporting and Capital Markets**

You should acquire the relevant knowledge from books instead of the lecture. Prof. Wüstemann is nice but unable to convey knowledge.

Exercise Session was a disaster, Case Study and Lecture were great

Unfriendly exercise teacher, was usually not recorded, weird relationship with PWC (...)

### **ACC 530** Group Accounting

Exam style (online exam with no option to return to previous question felt inappropriate

Each lecture Prof. Simons saw the slides for the very first time. He understood even less than the students.

TAX 620 Applied Empirical Research: Methods and **Practical Implementation** 

A lot of effort - challenging and sometimes frustrating, but I learnt a lot

A bit "nerdy" but very cool course if you are interested in statistics and want to learn a statistical program (R), also suitable for students without deeper interest in tax

The idea of the course is amazing (nothing similar is provided at the Uni MA)! However, could be structured in a better way. One is kind of "left alone"(...)

### **IS 540** Management of Enterprise Systems

Very interesting class with industry insights. Fair Exam!

Only "top level" information, models and definitions. Very bland and lacks value. I took this as a recommended prerequisite to Business Intelligence and regret the decision.

Not much value added.

Time in the exam was way too short, exam was like 6x the "test" exam

# **IS 602** Business Intelligence and Business Analytics Systems

Very chaotic and time-intensive case study, unfavorable final exam

Poorly organized, e.g. relevant information about the case studies were only given shortly before the deadline

### **IS 554** Computational Thinking

Very motivated and supportive professor and overall a very good introductory course for programming

Great online teaching, interactive classrooms model should be extended to more classes

The exercise session should be done online as well. Coding part was rather confusing without actually being taught how to do it. This course did not benefit from the online set-up.

# **IS 614** Corporate Knowledge Management

Exam criteria was very comprehensible but the actual exam was only evaluating if you can write faster than the others.

Interesting lectures and very nice structure of the course (exam already in November).

### MAN 645 Leadership and Motivation

One of the worst courses of my studies

Enjoyable and interesting lectures. However, I didn't feel fully informed on what to expect from the exam.

Very theoretical and boring. I had expected something different when I chosed this module

exam was not fair at all

### **MKT 570** Marketing of Innovations

Great course! Very practice-oriented with a case study with Mercedes AMG. Relatively high effort during the semester, but no exam! Thanks to Prof. Kuester for her effort.

Unnecessarily strict grading.
4 ECTS is absolutely not sufficient for the effort required for that course.

### **MKT 560** Services Marketing

Case-Study based learning is Nice and exam was very close to what was discussed during lecture

Little theoretical input but open discussions about real world topics! How a master course should be!

not enough real content was taught in contrast to the many cases that were discussed but not based on a theoretical foundation

### **MKT 612** Business-to-Business-Marketing

Interesting and short course.

### MKT 613 Verhandlungsführung

Great insights into negotiations from practitioners

Grading too strict, not transparent

Did not translate well into the online format.

The final case had little to do with the content that was covered.
