




## Spring Term 2022: MMM Satisfaction




## MMM-Areas: Specialization and Satisfaction





#### Which courses did you take this semester? (n = 143)










How would you rate the quality of this course?









## Comments: Business Economics II (I)



- Grading very unfavourable, too harsh and intransparent
- Lectures were unstructured and chaotic
- High workload/too much effort
- Extreme quantity of mistakes in course decks and videos

"Lecturer was the kindest person on earth, however that doesn't help as she is **unable to transfer and explain the concepts to the students**. An understanding of those concepts, however, is absolutely crucial if one wants to succeed."

"The professor made quite a few mistakes & I couldn't follow her most times due to her **fast calculations**. **More explanations** would have been helpful & not just reading out calculations that are already on the slides."

## Comments: Business Economics II (II)



"The difficulty of the **exam varies** every year from lecturer to **lecturer**. Unfair as this is a core course"

"The assistants teaching the exercise courses are more valuable than the lecturer"

"This course is completely useless, please make it non-mandatory; Prof. was hard to understand (verbally); slides often contained mistakes and were hard to understand; why are they giving this course to a new Prof. every semester?"

"Professor was very kind and fair"

"I liked the professor's teaching style"

"Exam review wasn't well organized"

"I can't believe that such a quality is offered at the University of Mannheim - really have no words for that"









## Comments: **Decision Analysis**



"The content of the lecture is fine.
The grading of the exam however is a desaster (unfair, intransparent)"

"The professor is very unpleasant and demanding. She wants each and every student to follow anything she says and she is not available for questions and comments after May 23rd, which is not fair given that it is her job to help students understand topics."

"Unfair grading"

"Attitude of the professor was sometimes very rude and unprofessional. The **grading** seemed very harsh and points were deducted harshly for small mistakes in the exam"




Have you applied for a seminar thesis this semester?



## Comments: Seminar Thesis (I)



"(...) I feel like there should be more standard regulations concerning the seminars so that there are not huge differences across areas and chairs."

"The written part should make up more of the Overall grade (not just 60%) as way more time is needed for writing the thesis than preparing the final presentation."

"Bad ECTS to effort ratio"

"Thesis topic had to be found on our own within a very large area"









# Comments: Seminar Thesis (II)



### Logistics chair:

- Bad ECTS ratio
- Not enough support from supervisor ("we were only allowed to schedule 3 meeting with our supervisor")
  - Not possible to get a very good grade
- "I personally am super interested in the topic of logistics and SCM but this thesis **completely lowered my interest** and I am not looking forward to writing my master's thesis at all."

"Too much time required for 6 ECTS" (OPM seminar) "A **huge effort for 6 ECTS**, fair grading, but it took 11 weeks for grading" (OPM seminar)







## Master Thesis: Topic Assignment







# Master Thesis: **Defense**





"Talk to Profs if they **seriously violate student rights** (e.g. in one exam 70 points for 60 minutes even though Prof said beforehand there will be 70 minutes)!"

### Comments: FIN Courses



#### FIN 603 – Empirical Finance

Great course which prepares optimally for writing a seminar/master thesis in the Finance Area. The benefit of the exercise classes was little bit lacking and the participation grading was not transparent.

#### FIN 620 – Behavioral Finance

Very interesting course; The grade compensates the high effort of reading all the literature.

Exam was not representative of the course. However, the course in general was very interesting.

#### FIN 685 – Banking Regulation

'Mid-Term' on the last day of the lectures is not a Mid-Term but an earlier exam.

Therefore this did not help at all in relaxing the examination period but made it worse as one expected the exam to take place much earlier.

# FIN 686 – Sustainable Finance and Impact Investing

Great guest lecturer who is very passionate about Impact Investing and its implications.
Group work could use a little bit more guidance. Very high workload concentrated on one week right before the exam period was not optimal.

### FIN 682 International Asset Management

The guest lectures were pretty bad.









### Comments: IS Courses



### IS 512 – IT Management in the Digital Age

Case Study Sessions interesting but high workload if you really want to follow (these sessions are not graded btw).

The Prof talks a lot about his experiences, which is interesting, but the topic itself is pretty dry.

Theory is a bit outdated, but cases are very interesting.

Exam instructions were not clear.

The exam and it's questions are very random and you can't really prepare for it. The questions are mostly not about the lecture content and are very broad. This results in an subjective and very frustrating grading. Content itself is kind of interesting.

### IS 513 – Applied IT Management in the Digital Age

Have expected more from this course.

Very interesting course + case study, very fair exam, highly recommend.

#### IS 622 – Network Science

Strict grading in a closed-book (!) online exam, almost no partial points given; Python-Assignments should be graded (main workload of this course).

Do NOT take this course! Workload is ridiculously high, exam grading very unfavourable, almost no application to business topics, chair does not know how things work at Uni Mannheim.

### IS 629 – Agile Software Product Management and Design

Case study is very time consuming and requires lot of efforts.









## Comments: MAN Courses (I)



#### MAN 632 – Advanced Entrepreneurship

Really interesting course, with many guest lectures from real founders/start-ups. However, the lectures from the chair are boring and unstructured. You have to prepare 4 little and interesting case studies.

MAN 639 TRANSFORM - Innovation & Entrepreneurship for Sustainability

Very high workload, not very clear what they expected

#### MAN 648 Incentives and Performance

Very interesting and great lectures! But to get an outstanding grade you have to be very precise and creative in the exam

The exam was completely random

### MAN 654 Corporate Restructuring

Exam had a very unfair question from guest lecture that people weren't aware of to prepare for. Otherwise, case study offered high quality presentations and great insights but should count more than 25% since they were very time intensive.

Strict grading, "learn every sentence by heart"exam

Close to practical issues

Group presentation takes lots of time & should have a higher Influence on the overall grade.

Difficult exam

Very interesting and well-structured course! You gain a lot of advanced management knowledge!
