






Fall Term 2024: MMM Satisfaction



How would you rate your overall satisfaction with the MMM program?









Why did you choose the University of Mannheim for your master studies? (multiple answers possible)









Which of the following sources did you use to inform yourself about the MMM before your application? (multiple answers possible)

















Fall Term 2024: **Application Twice a Year**

I stressed myself really a lot about the GMAT, but in the end i would have been accepted also without the **GMAT** Points.















Supply-Demand gap especially for Marketing and Management Courses

Comments: Business Economics Main Issues



1. Issues with the course structure – gap between lecture and exercise

- "Problem Sets introduce topics and approaches that were never mentioned in the lecture"
- "What professor explains is very different from exercise questions."
- "the disconnect between the video and in the class session makes the course extremely challenging for studying"

2. Quality of exercise sessions and material




What system of assigning the topics did the chair use?


Did you defend your master thesis?






Did you receive an offer for an exchange semester?









Did you receive an offer for a Double Degree or EMT-Program?




Did you spend your semester in Mannheim or abroad?





To which extent did the semester abroad support your academic education?









Semester Abroad: Accreditation and Grading




How would you rate the conversion of the grades received abroad?







